FRIDAY SIDE MATCH
SHOOT ALL DAY FOR \$15.00

SPEED SHOTGUN ATB - ENGAGE THE 4 SHOTGUN KNOCK DOWNS - MUST GO DOWN TO SCORE. FASTEST TIME WINS, SHOOT AS MANY TIMES AS YOU WANT.

SPEED RIFLE ATB – ENGAGE THE 5 RIFLE TARGETS, LEFT TO RIGHT THEN RIGHT TO LEFT. FASTEST TIME WINS, SHOOT AS MANY TIMES AS YOU WANT.

SPEED HANDGUN ATB – ENGAGE THE FIVE HANDGUN TARGETS LEFT TO RIGHT THEN RIGHT TO LEFT. FASTEST TIME WINS,. SHOOT AS MANY TIMES AS YOU WANT.

WILD BUNCH ATB- FROM THE LEFT SPOOL SHOOT THE RIFLE AT THE 5 RIFLE TARGETS LEFT TO RIGHT THEN RIGHT TO LEFT, MOVE TO THE MIDDLE SPOOL SHOOT THE STAGED 1911 AT THE 5, 1911 TARGETS LEFT TO RIGHT THEN RIGHT TO LEFT, MOVE TO THE RIGHT SPOOL SHOOT THE SHOTGUN AT THE 5 SHOTGUN KNOCKDOWNS FROM LEFT TO RIGHT MUST GO DOWN TO SCORE.

RJSS RULES ARE USED FOR THE WID BUNCH, NOT SASS RULES.

WILD BUNCH CLASSES, PIKE AND MEXICAN ONLY.

MEN AND WOMEN CLASSES WILL BE HONORED

Awards given with the Ambush awards.

LONG RANGE RIFLE AND WILD BILL SHOOT

These two events will be held after the SASS Black powder match on Fri and on Sat. after the Ambush.

AWARDS
